A BREAKTHROUGH IN THE FIGHT AGAINST CANINE ORAL MELANOMA

Canine oral melanoma remains one of the most aggressive cancers in dogs, but immunotherapy is changing the treatment landscape. ONCEPT[®] Canine Melanoma Vaccine (DNA) is the first therapeutic DNA vaccine developed to stimulate a dog's immune system against melanoma cells by targeting the tyrosinase protein. Designed for dogs with Stage II or III oral melanoma after successful local disease control through surgery and/or radiation, ONCEPT is not a preventive vaccine but an innovative adjunct therapy aimed at extending survival while maintaining quality of life. By harnessing the body's own immune response rather than directly attacking cancer cells, this breakthrough represents a significant milestone in veterinary oncology and highlights the growing role of immunotherapy in improving outcomes for canine cancer patients.



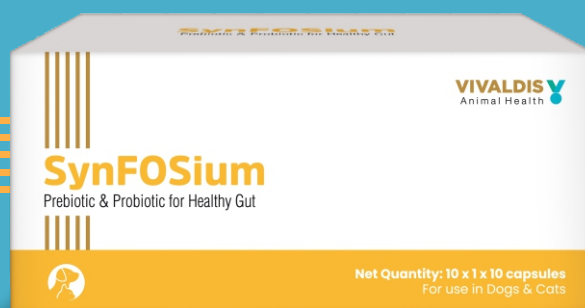

LOOKING BEYOND CLINICAL SIGNS: DETECTING HIDDEN GI INFLAMMATION IN DOGS ON LONG-TERM NSAIDS

Long-term NSAID therapy plays a vital role in managing chronic pain, especially in dogs with osteoarthritis, but gastrointestinal inflammation may develop long before obvious clinical signs appear. An award-winning study presented at VOACON 2026 by researchers from Carus Animal Health and the University of Bristol found that some dogs receiving chronic oral NSAIDs had elevated faecal calprotectin levels, despite showing no visible gastrointestinal symptoms. The findings highlight the potential of faecal calprotectin as a simple, non-invasive biomarker for early detection of GI inflammation, enabling veterinarians to monitor patients more proactively, make informed treatment decisions, and improve the long-term safety of NSAID therapy. This research represents an important step toward preventive, biomarker-guided care in veterinary medicine.

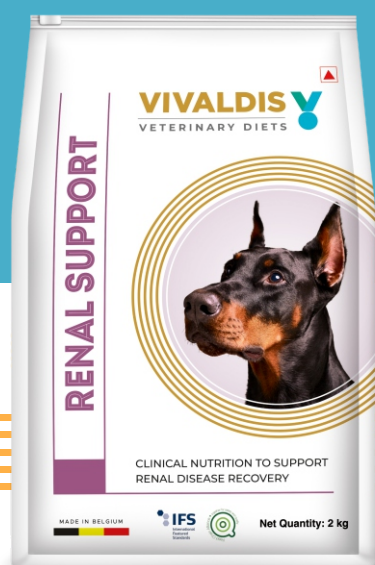

EARLY NUTRITIONAL INTERVENTION CAN CHANGE THE COURSE OF FELINE KIDNEY DISEASE

Chronic kidney disease (CKD) is one of the most common chronic illnesses affecting aging cats, and a recent study published in the Journal of the American Veterinary Medical Association (JAVMA) provides compelling evidence that early nutritional intervention can significantly improve outcomes. Researchers evaluated 1,430 cats with early-stage CKD (IRIS Stages 1 and 2), including 839 cats that were consistently fed a therapeutic renal diet and 591 cats that were not. The findings were striking—cats receiving a renal diet had a 41–46% lower risk of CKD progression and survived an average of 31 months, compared with 26 months in cats that did not receive renal nutrition. These results reinforce the importance of introducing a therapeutic renal diet early, rather than waiting for advanced disease. By helping reduce kidney workload, manage phosphorus levels, and provide targeted nutritional support, renal diets can significantly slow disease progression and improve both longevity and quality of life. This study further highlights that early diagnosis combined with timely nutritional intervention should be a cornerstone of feline CKD management, empowering veterinarians to make a meaningful difference in the lives of their patients..
